Community Improvement Projects

CURRENT PROJECTS

Multiple improvement projects are underway and progressing on schedule throughout Brentwood Hills. Here's a review of current projects:

- Fence replacement: The overall project is nearly complete with only two sections along Lumsden Road on either side of Mt. Carmel remaining. Fencing along the east side of the community is scheduled to be replaced beginning in late October.
- Play and Sports Equipment:

 A new tot's swing set has been added to the big playground, and our soccer goals are being replaced.
- Landscaping: We have a new landscaper attending to our common areas and doing an excellent job!

UPCOMING PROJECTS

The board has several improvement projects scheduled. Watch for these projects in the near future:

- Entrances: The main entrance monuments will be completely redone. Landscaping at all entrances will be upgraded and improved.
- Sports and Recreation Areas: The bidding process has started for a basketball court next to the tennis courts, in addition to new lighting for extended evening use of these facilities.
- Pool: The swimming pool is scheduled to be resurfaced, and the pool pumps and equipment will be replaced this fall.

Student Safety Reminders

School is back in session and children of all ages will be walking to and from their bus stops. Drivers should also be alert for groups of students gathered at corners waiting for their school bus. REMINDER: All vehicles must stop on both sides of the road when the bus is stopped and the red lights are flashing.

Additionally, if you are waiting in a vehicle to pick up your child/ children from the bus stop, please pull to the side of the

road and away from the intersection so that other traffic can safely pass. Speed and visibility are key factors in assuring the safety of all our children and other pedestrians in the community.
