#### **Community Improvement Projects**

Our HOA rules state that all trash and recycle carts must be stored "out of sight" until 6:00 pm the night before collection. Carts may be stored

in your garage or along the side of your house if they're BEHIND concealing bushes or fencing. Wherever you choose to store your carts, they must be "out of sight".



The two smaller cans pictured on the left will be available early next year if desired.

Cart Swap-Out Period - The county is asking all residents to give the new, larger roll carts a "test drive" through the holidays when many households generate more trash. After that, if a smaller sized cart is more practical, residents can contact their service provider between January 15 and March 15 for a free exchange. After March 15, it

will cost \$30 to swap for a different size.

Collection schedules and information about service

providers was included in the instruction packets distributed with the new roll carts. If you need to contact your service provider, you can visit the county

#### Holiday Safety Tip for Homeowners

The number 1 cause of fires during the holidays is overloaded electrical outlets. Manufacturers suggest stringing no more than three sets of lights together. Also, use multiple outlets for those inside lights and elec-



trical appliances--don't try to put them all into one outlet using extenders. Surge protectors are another important safety feature to consider installing. Have a safe and happy holiday!
