Children and Pool Rules—Urgent

Over the summer, there were several instances where Pool Rule #5 was not observed by parents. This rule clearly states **children under 12**

MUST be accompanied by a guardian age 16 or older. Just to be clear, "accompanied"

means you have to stay with them. If you need to leave for any reason for any amount of time, you must take children under 12 with you. You CAN-NOT drop off your young children and expect our staff to babysit for you. That is not their job. If this happens again

> the Hillsborough County Sheriff and Child Services will be notified and the child placed in their

custody. Also, but not nearly as important, you will lose your pool privileges—forever!

New Pool Hours:


