### **Roofing Standards Updated**

During the November meeting, a change in roofing standards was agreed upon by the Board.

For asphalt shingles, 3 dimensional shingles are the new standard, with 1 dimensional flat shingles (three-tab) no longer being allowed. The approved colors are Slate, Weathered Wood, Shakewood, Hickory, Sunrise Brick, and Driftwood. These colors may be viewed at

For tile roofs, the approved colors are Cloud Grey, Mahogany Elegenza, Pioneer Orange, Rustic Red, Sandy Brown, Terracotta Classic, Metallic Clay, and Pioneer Red. These colors may be viewed at www.polycarbonatedome.com.

Please remember that a shingle roof must stay a shingle roof, and a terracotta tile roof must stay tile!

## Trimming Crape Myrtles Is Not Recommended

The question has arisen whether

to trim your crape myrtles back in the winter. We reached out to the University of Florida IFAS extension and learned occasional pruning for a desired shape is fine but butchering back to



stubs or "knobs" is not. New growth from these points is actually structurally weak and

structurally weak and leaves the tree more susceptible to fungus disease.
