Landscaping and Irrigation

Our irrigation continues to be rehabilitated, enabling the advancing efforts landscape of the rehabilitation. Once the irrigation is fully working the HOA board will evaluate our sod requirement.

The landscaping team, in coordination with irrigation, will be placing annuals in the flower beds in the coming weeks. New mulch has been laid in appropriate areas. The landscaping effort is on track and on budget.
