The board's goal is to create a safe and enjoyable living environment while simultaneously striving to maintain and even raise the home values of our members. COMMUNITY UPDATES

BASKETBALL COURT

The board has approved a 2-hoop basketball court adjacent to the tennis courts. This court will have the same control-access as the community center, falling under the same rules and video surveillance. We expect the court to be completed o/a 15 Feb 2020.

DOG PARK

The board has approved a dog park in the open field within the common area. This dog park, among other added amenities, brings our community up to par with newly constructed communities, thereby maintaining our home values and creating a more enjoyable place to live. REFORESTATION

The board has approved a 2020 Phase I plan to reforest the area adjacent to S. Mt. Carmel. This effort, which includes a second well, should be in full swing no later than 1 May 2020.

COMMUNITY FENCE

A priority for 2020 is to repair applicable areas of the community fence. In so doing, it is imperative that homeowners have their back yard foliage removed from the fence, as this can cause erosion.

PARKING ON GRASS

Though some members of the board assumed it is explicitly addressed that parking vehicles on the grass is prohibited, we cannot find that language. Therefore, we expect a policy letter addressing such will be introduced during meeting in November.

OTHER NEWS

Interior Entrance Monuments – While initial plans were for the interior monuments on east side of BH to be replaced with upgraded monuments, on par with color and design of those along Mt. Carmel, we discovered the original monuments were never permitted and replacements would not be permitted today. We are striving to find a solution that brings these entrances up to par with the rest of the community.

Grants – It is the purpose of the board to bring back to our community as many of our tax dollars and take advantage of other available funds, as possible. These funds off-set community projects such as annual community celebration, hedges, Little Free Library, and reforestation.

Assessments – While there are many plans to improve our community amenities, while simultaneously taking care of what we already have, ensuring all maintained well, HOA fees will not be raised in 2020. Initial projections see no current need to raise fees through 2025.
