2021 Budget Meeting Recap

HOA DUES TO INCREASE BY \$80

During the process of putting together the 2021 budget – Dave Hodges (President), Denise Stearns (Treasurer) and the folks at McNeil Management – identified a need for more money in our reserve fund. With this in mind – the Board unexcitedly voted unanimously to increase quarterly dues by \$20 – for a total of \$80 per year.

The reserve fund is essentially a savings account. It is where the HOA saves money for more costly repairs and replacements.

Three things impacted the budget – money put aside for proper maintenance of the community and amenities, the Cost of Living Adjustment and the amount deposited into the reserve fund.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Brentwood Hills enjoys more amenities than any community in the area that is managed by HOA
- Amenities maintenance swimming pool, splash pad, grill / BBQ area, 2 playgrounds, 2 dog parks, tennis courts, basketball court, bocce ball, horseshoes and sports field
- Amenities improve the value of your home – and make the community more desirable
- If Cost of Living Adjustment had been made since 2011 – at 1.79% / year – the actual quarterly dues would have been \$170
- Landscaping will benefit from the increased funding – which is a major concern for many in the community
